2022 Regular General Election Information

The 2022 regular general election will be conducted primarily by mail. All active registered voters will be mailed a ballot between October 18th- November 1st. Mail in ballots must be postmarked by November 07, 2022. Logic and Accuracy will be conducted October 6th at 2 p.m. in the Clerk-Auditor's Office. In-person voting will be available from 7 a.m. – 8 p.m. on Election Day, November 8th and during Early Vote on October 25th – November 4th from 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. There will only be one polling location at the County Building 147 E Main St. Vernal, UT.

The voter registration deadline is October 28th, eleven days before the day of the election. An individual with a disability who is not able to vote a manual ballot by mail may obtain information on voting in an accessible manner from the county's website, by contacting the county clerk, or by reviewing the information included with a ballot mailed to the voter.

Ballot drop boxes will be available from October 18th – November 8th in the following locations:

- Naples City, 1420 E 2850 S, Naples - Hours: Monday – Thursday 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Ballard City, 2381 E 1000 S, Ballard - Hours: Monday – Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
