Logic and Accuracy testing will be conducted June 1, 2022 11:00 a.m. in the Clerk-Auditor's Office

Ballot drop box is located outside the Uintah County Library at 204 E. 100 N. Vernal. The ballot drop box will close at 8pm on June 28th.

Early voting will be available in the Clerk-Auditors office from June 14 through June 24 from 8am to 5 pm.

The last day to register to vote in person or online is June 17, 2022 at [vote.utah.gov](http://vote.utah.gov)

There will only be ONE Vote Center open on Election Day, Tuesday, June 28 in the Uintah County Commission Chambers 147 E Main, Vernal from 7 am to 8pm. You must bring in your ID and ballot if you received one.

An Audit will be held June 30th at 10 am in the Clerk-Auditor's Office. Board of Canvassers will convene July 11, 2022 in the Commission Chambers at 12pm.

This is a Closed Primary Election. Only those affiliated with the Republican Party will be mailed a Republican ballot. Unaffiliated voters may affiliate during early vote or on election day. Changing of party affiliation deadline was March 31, 2022, voters are not allowed to change parties until June 29th, 2022.
