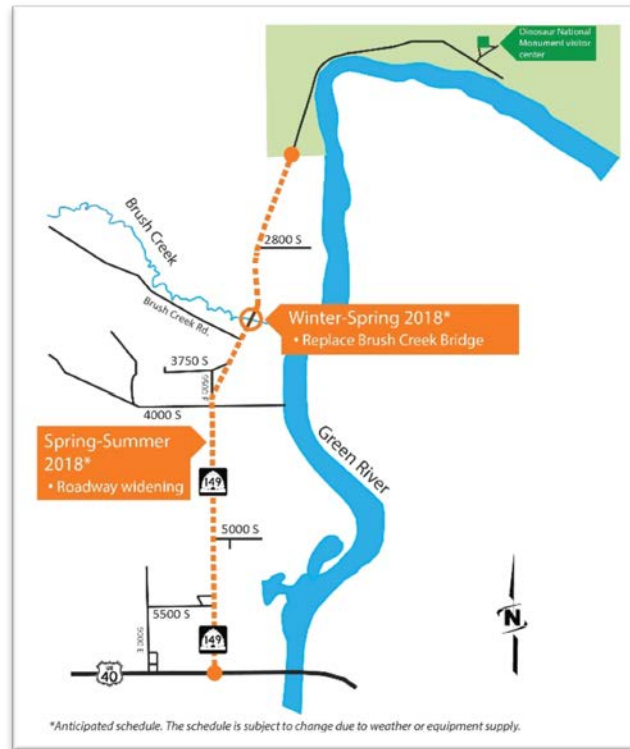


SR-149 Road Improvement Project to Dinosaur National Monument

PROJECT UPDATE: BRUSH CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT BEGINS JANUARY 2018

Beginning January 2018, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will start work on the SR-149 Road Improvement Project.



Project Schedule:

Residents and motorists should anticipate culvert and utility work beginning the week of January 8. Work to replace the Brush Creek Bridge is scheduled to begin with northbound lane closures on January 12. Bridge work is scheduled to be complete by May 2018.

Roadway widening and resurfacing activities are expected to begin in March and be complete by mid-summer 2018. This work will include widening the roadway 5 feet on each side to accommodate 12 foot wide travel lanes, and 4 foot wide paved shoulders.

Work was originally scheduled to begin November 2017, but the project start date was delayed due to bridge work phasing coordination and equipment supply.

Anticipated Impacts:

Work is scheduled to occur Monday through Friday during daytime hours with some weekend work possible. To accommodate work, SR-149 will be reduced to one lane at the bridge and at active construction work zones. A temporary traffic control signal will be in place at the bridge and one-way flagging will be in place when pipe work is occurring at various locations along the corridor. Please use caution and reduce speeds while driving through the work zones.
