

PRIMARY ELECTION  
INFORMATION

June 30, 2020

For this election Uintah County will have both a Democrat and a Republican Contest. Voters unaffiliated with any party may receive a Democrat Ballot, but they MUST request it from the Clerk-Auditor's Office.

If you are an unaffiliated voter and do not request a ballot OR if you are affiliated with any other party You will NOT automatically receive a ballot in the mail.

**In order to Vote on The REPUBLICAN BALLOT –**

You will be REQUIRED to affiliate with the Republican Party by June 19, 2020.

**In order to Vote on the DEMOCRAT BALLOT –**

You will be REQUIRED to either affiliate with the Democratic Party by June 19, 2020 or be Unaffiliated with any political party and request a Democratic Ballot prior to June 19, 2020

REGISTRATION

You MUST be registered to vote by June 19, 2020.

You can also affiliate with or change political parties if you desire, prior to June 19, 2020.

VOTERS WITH A DISABILITY

HOW DO I VOTE?

Ballot Drop Box: You may drop your ballot, between June 9<sup>th</sup> – June 30<sup>th</sup>, in one of the following ballot drop box locations: Outside of the Uintah County Library or Inside the Uintah County Building. Ballot Drop Boxes are open until 5 PM except on June 30<sup>th</sup>, they'll be open until 8 PM

Mail: You may also vote through mail by placing your ballot in the yellow return envelope provided.

**\*Important Covid 19 changes to the  
June 30, 2020 Primary Election**

- There will be no regular polling places on Election Day
- There will be no in person voting and no in person early voting
- There will be no in person voter registration
- There will be no voter registration by provisional ballot
- The voter registration deadline is June 19<sup>th</sup> (11 days before election day)
- All Ballots whether mailed or placed in drop boxes must be placed in the yellow envelopes provided with the ballots, and must be signed for in the proper area on the envelope.
